Product Name: CariFree Oral Neutralizer Gel – Mint Flavor

Ingredients:

Glycerin, Hydrogenated Starch Hydrolysate, Hydroxyethyl Cellulose, Menthol, Natural Flavors, Polysorbate 20, Potassium Sorbate, Sodium Benzoate, Sodium Bicarbonate, Sodium Hydroxide, Sodium Lauryl Sulfate, Water, Xylitol.

Description:

CariFree Oral Neutralizer Gel is a water-based dental topical gel containing xylitol and proprietary pH+ technology for the neutralization of an oral biofilm and saliva replacement for xerostomic patients.

Recommended Indications:

To be used as a toothpaste replacement as directed by a dental professional. Can also be used as a saliva replacement for patients with low saliva flow, and for neutralization of an acidic oral biofilm. CariFree Oral Neutralizer Gel can be used as many times daily as needed. A minimum of twice daily is recommended.

Contraindications:

None known. CariFree Oral Neutralizer Gel is safe for use by adults and children.

Directions for use:

1. Gently shake bottle before using.
2. Apply a generous bead of gel to a toothbrush or your finger and apply to tooth surfaces, including interproximal areas, using an interproximal brush if necessary. Gel will foam if using a toothbrush for application.
3. It is not necessary to expectorate gel and prolonged exposure to gel may result in increased neutralization of oral biofilm and moistening of oral tissues. Gel or foam may be expectorated if preferred.
4. Gel may be added to a custom tray for longer exposure.

Store at room temperature. Do not freeze.

Caution:

1. Always replace cap after use.
2. Supervise children's use for proper oral hygiene care.
3. In case of contact with eyes, flush with water and seek medical attention if necessary.
4. Note: a small amount of product separation may occur, gently shake prior to use.
